Connecting Sapphire V12 to SQL Server

For Sapphire V12 connects to SQL Server through use of a setting held in the registry:

Computer\HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\SapphireSQL\SQLSERVER

This setting will be the name of the SQL Server instance you wish to connect to.

Each SQL Server instance requires a Database named "SapphireSystemManager". This database has tables which hold data on users and company datasets.

Sapphire V12 can only point to one SQL Server instance at one time. This means if you have multiple instances installed on your network, you can choose which clients use which instance by changing their registry setting.

If, for example, you have two independent servers (at different physical locations) and need to migrate one to the other, you can set up a new instance on SQL Server and copy Sapphire System Manager and any company datasets to the new instance and then point the clients to this new instance.
